<b>A. Central Information</b>	Required information properly displayed? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Safety poster and emergency info</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Application info &amp; posted before application</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Workers/handlers aware of location &amp; accessible</i></li> </ul> Information displayed for required time? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Central info up for 30 days after last REI if workers/handlers present</i></li> </ul>		
<b>B. Safety Training</b>	Required Training Provided <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Handler/worker training provided meets requirements</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Retraining every 5 years</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Handlers/early entry workers trained before doing tasks</i></li> </ul> Qualified trainer(s) used? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Certified applicator</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Trainer of certified applicators</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Attended approved train-the-trainer course</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Trained WPS handlers for worker training</i></li> </ul>		
<b>C. Decontamination</b>	Required decontamination and items provided? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Provide for all handler/early entry tasks, when workers in area within 30 days of REI (7 days if REI 4hrs. or less)</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Workers: clean water, soap, single-use towels, change of clothing (if eyewear required, --immediate access to 1 pt. eye flush.)</i></li> </ul> Requirements for decontamination location met? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Within ¼ mi., at mix sites, at PPE removal sites, access to eye flush</i></li> </ul>		
<b>D. Entry Restrictions</b>	Restrictions during application met? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>No persons allowed in treated area if not handler</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Buffer zones for nurseries /greenhouses met</i></li> </ul> REI requirements met? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Workers not in REI area except when allowed by WPS</i></li> </ul> Exceptions to REI's appropriate? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>No contact, allowed short-term tasks, ag emergency, approved exceptions (limited contact, irrigation)</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Requirements for early entry met (provide &amp; maintain PPE, read label safety info, prevent heat illness, have decontamination)</i></li> </ul>		
<b>E. Notice of Application</b>	Workers given required notifications? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Oral warning, posted treated areas, double notification if required</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Signs not posted before 24 hrs of application, removed w/n 3 days of application and before worker entry</i></li> </ul> Required posting used? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Have in English &amp; Spanish (or other language) "Danger Pesticides—Keep Out" with WPS symbol in center</i></li> <li>▪ <i>Size: standard 14"x 16", smaller size in greenhouse &lt; 25' apart</i></li> </ul> Oral warnings contain required information? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Location/description, time entry restricted, instruct not to enter</i></li> </ul>		
<b>F. Personal Protective Equipment</b>	Required PPE provided? Duties of PPE met? Measures to avoid heat illness taken?		
<b>G. Information Exchange</b>	Required exchange between employers met?		
<b>H. Monitoring Duties</b>	Visual/voice contact every 2 hrs. w/ handler using a product with skull and crossbones? Greenhouse fumigator has continual monitoring? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <i>Visual/voice contact with another handler with PPE</i></li> </ul>		
<b>I. Inform Handlers</b>	Handlers have immediate label access and safety information? Handlers instructed in proper equipment use?

<b>J. Equipment Duties</b>	Handlers inspect equipment before use?		
<b>K. Inform others</b>	PPE cleaners informed that PPE may be contaminated and risks? Contracted equipment workers/mechanics informed of pesticide risks?		
<b>L. Crop Advisor Exemption</b>	Meet crop advisor exemption requirements?
