

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

**Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Mixers, Loaders, Applicators and other handlers must wear: long sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks. ### FIRST AID

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

Mushroom Supplement Preservative protects the mushroom supplement from molds commonly present in compost. Shake container or stir concentrate well before diluting. Ensure application equipment is clean before use. Suspension must be agitated constantly during application.

To a finished batch of mushroom supplement add up to 0.2% (by weight) of Mushroom Supplement Preservative. A solvent should be used when adding Mushroom Supplement Preservative to mushroom supplement in order to uniformly apply the product. If compatibility with other chemicals is unknown, consult the distributor for recommendations. This product may not be applied through irrigation systems.

### AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this production only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 C.F.R. Part 170. This standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE) and restricted-entry interval. ### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Container Disposal** – Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or alternatives allowed by state and local authorities.
