A maximum of 4 applications per crop may be made at 7 to 14 day intervals. Do not apply within 2 days of harvest. Do not apply more than 3.5 lbs product (2.45 lbs a.i.)/A/crop.

If more than one benzimidazole product (i.e. a product containing benomyl as the active ingredient) is used, the total poundage of all such products must not exceed 3.5 lbs.

The EPA Headquarters and EPA Regional Office shall immediately be informed of any adverse effects or misuse resulting from applications made in connection with this specific exemption.
